


OPIOID ADDICTION

Dr. Lofgran's team has been successfully treating patients for opioid addiction since 2004. With the use of medications such as Buprenorphine, Naltrexone, and Sublocade, many patients are able to live normal lives and engage in school, careers, and with their families. ALCOHOL ADDICTION

Alcohol abuse can often go undetected. However, the costs to our communities are huge—from impacting personal family relationships to costing billions of dollars in legal and medical fees. Roughly 88,000 Americans die each year due to excessive alcohol consumption, yet alcoholism remains misunderstood and misrepresented.

There is help through counseling, medications, and other modes of treatment. New medications, such as Naltrexone and Acamprostate, have opened the door for successful recovery. If you or someone you know has signs of alcohol abuse, please seek help.

Dr. Lofgran takes the treatment of addiction very seriously. While willing to help patients through the difficulties of addiction (including relapse), patients are required to fully engage and participate completely in the treatment program, including attending counseling, regular meetings and appointments. Other components of a holistic approach to treatment are accepted and encouraged.

Dr. Lofgran and his team do not treat chronic pain. However, we are more than willing to consult and propose a plan for those individuals who are interested in getting off their chronic pain medications.
