

North Canyon Medical Center Charity Care Program

Eligibility for charity care is based on family size and family income of the applicant by using the federal poverty guidelines chart. The following poverty guidelines chart will be used to determine the percent (%) that will be the patient responsibility.

**Poverty Guidelines Chart

- Under the poverty guidelines 100% of the account balance will be written off and the patient responsibility will be 0%
- At the poverty guideline to 125% - 75% of the account will be written off and the patient responsibility will be 25%
- At 125% of the poverty guideline to 150% - 50% of the account balance will be written off and the and the patient responsibility will be 50%
- At 150% of the poverty guideline to 175% - 25% of the account balance will be written off and the patient responsibility will be 75%
- Above 175% of the poverty guideline to 0% of the account balance will be written off and the patient responsibility will be 0%

For Example: If your family size is 4 and your family income is 35,000, then 50% of the account balance will be written off and 50% of the account balance will be your responsibility.

To be considered for charity care, the applicant must submit the following documents:

- Financial Application
- Last pay stub/ 30 days of income and employer information
- Last year's Federal tax returns
- Current W-2's
