



Revised Visitor Policy

Updated 7/1/2021

Visiting Hours

Visiting hours are from 7:00am – 7:00pm.

Visitor Criteria

- Must be 18 years and older.
- A mask must be worn at all times.
- Must be screened upon entrance to the facility for COVID symptoms.
- Visitors with respiratory symptoms (cough, congestion, shortness of breath) or fever above 100.4 will not be allowed into the facility.
- Must stay in the patient rooms at all times.
- Patients positive with COVID-19 will NOT be allowed visitors.

Inpatient Visitors

- Inpatients are allowed 3 visitors per day, with a limit of two visitors at a time.
- Families are encouraged to use FaceTime, Skype and visits from outside the patient room window.
- Exceptions to the visitor policy will be made for:
 - Patients with a disability requiring an essential support person to assist with communication, or other disability-related needs if staff are unable to provide such assistance.
 - Cognitive and developmentally impaired patients including, but not limited to dementia, Alzheimer's, disruptive behavior, and altered mental (where caregiver provides safety).

Emergency Room

Emergency room patients are allowed one visitor who meets the above Visitor Criteria.

Outpatient Care (Clinics & Surgery)

Outpatients and surgery patients are allowed one visitor who meets the above Visitor Criteria.

Visitation Exceptions

Exceptions to the visitor policy will be made for:

- Patients with a disability requiring an essential support person to assist with communication, or other disability-related needs if staff are unable to provide such assistance.
- Cognitive and developmentally impaired patients including, but not limited to dementia, Alzheimer's, disruptive behavior, and altered mental status (where caregiver provides safety).
